



During the 2004-05 academic year, a total of 12,139 students received grants totaling \$8,336,903. The average grant was Grants to college students at dozens of Ne- \$687.

Schools select students as potential re-Grants were made to 14.106 students cipients, and the Coordinating Commission for Post-Secondary Education approves the students and distributes funds to the institutions. Grants are made based on financial need, and students are not guaranteed to receive the grant every year they are enrolled.

> The Nebraska Scholarship Fund uses a blend of funding from the United States Department of Education's LEAP/SLEAP program (4 percent in 2008-09), the State of Nebraska General Fund (53 percent in 2008-09), and Nebraska Lottery proceeds (43 percent in 2008-09).

> Nebraska Lottery proceeds are being used in many ways to help people and projects across our state, supporting efforts focused on areas such as education, the environment, compulsive gamblers assistance, and the Nebraska State Fair. So far. \$357 million has been raised for Nebraska Lottery beneficiary funds.
