

BUILDING A BETTER NEBRASKA



Did vou know when you buy a Nebraska Lottery ticket, you're helping to build a better Nebraska? A portion of every ticket sold goes to support the environment, education, the Nebraska State Fair, and compulsive gamblers assistance. During the fiscal year that ended June 30, 2017, a total of \$41.2 million in lottery proceeds were distributed to Lottery beneficiary funds. Here is some information about how that money is used:

ENVIRONMENT

The Nebraska Environmental Trust is the sole environmental beneficiary fund. The Trust operates a grant program for natural resources work in our state. The Trust accepts grant applications annually, usually in September. Almost any good idea to improve Nebraska's environment can be considered for grant funding, but the current funding categories are Habitat: Surface and Ground Water; Waste Management; Air Quality; and Soil Management. In April 2017, the Trust announced that 85 projects would receive \$16.7 million in lottery proceeds during the Trust's 24th year of grants.

EDUCATION

A share of proceeds equal to 44.5 percent is dedicated to educational purposes, as determined by the Legislature. Currently the Nebraska Education Improvement Fund receives all of the lottery proceeds dedicated to education and distributes these funds to other educational programs, such as the Nebraska Opportunity Grant Program.

Administered by the Coordinating Commission for Post-Secondary Education, the Nebraska Opportunity Grant Program offers need-based scholarships to students in the University of Nebraska System, Nebraska State College System, and Community College System. A total of 85,552 need-based scholarships have been funded using lottery proceeds.

STATE FAIR

Dating to 1868, the Nebraska State Fair offers hundreds of attractions including many entertainers, exhibits, midway rides, and delicious food. The Nebraska State Fair combines tradition with innovation to produce an educational and exciting event for the entire family. Lottery proceeds are used by the Nebraska State Fair for facility improvements at the fairgrounds.

COMPULSIVE GAMBLERS ASSISTANCE

Gambling can be an enjoyable source of entertainment for many people. But for some people, gambling can be addictive. Lottery proceeds to the Gamblers Assistance program are used to operate the Problem Gambling Help Line (800-522-4700) and provide help for players dealing with gambling addiction.

WINNING WAYS

Grand Island Woman Claims \$1 Million Powerball Prize



Melinda Rother of Grand Island won \$1 million playing Powerball from the Nebraska Lottery.

Rother has been purchasing Powerball tickets from Casey's General Store at 1814 North Eddy St. in Grand Island for several years. Her most-recent winning ticket contained one play that matched all five of the winning white ball numbers (11, 21, 31, 41, 59) from the May 6 drawing for \$1 million.

While claiming her prize May 8, Rother said she had no idea she had a winning ticket from Saturday's drawing until late Sunday evening. She learned she had won while checking the winning numbers at nelottery.com with her husband.

Rother told Lottery officials she was surprised when she learned she had won. "I feel blessed every day when I get up," she said. "This was the extra icing on the cupcake."

Rother stated she has not made any definite plans for the prize yet, but said she would use the money to buy a new grill and help her sister pursue her degree as a veterinary technician. She also plans to share with her son as well as her niece and nephew. She and her husband's lifestyles will stay the same and she plans to continue to teach Sunday school at her church as well as volunteering time at the Salvation Army. "We're not really going to change anything," she said. "We're very blessed."

LAST CALL PROGRAM

The Nebraska Lottery has launched a new program called Last Call.

A Last Call Scratch game is a game that is nearing the end of its sales cycle. A Scratch game designated as a Last Call game will be on sale for a maximum of 30 additional days. When 30 days have passed or when the last top prize has been claimed, the game will be closed.



Additionally, when a game is designated as a Last Call game, a secondchance promotion for that game will begin. MVP Club members can enter non-winning tickets at nelottery.com for a chance to win a pack of Scratch tickets of their choice. Tickets can be entered up to 14 days after the close of the designated game.

Notices about Last Call Scratch games will be posted at Nebraska Lottery retailers, on the Lottery website, and on Lottery social media channels. The next time you're buying a Scratch ticket, look for the Last Call logo. It just might open up a whole new way for you to win.
