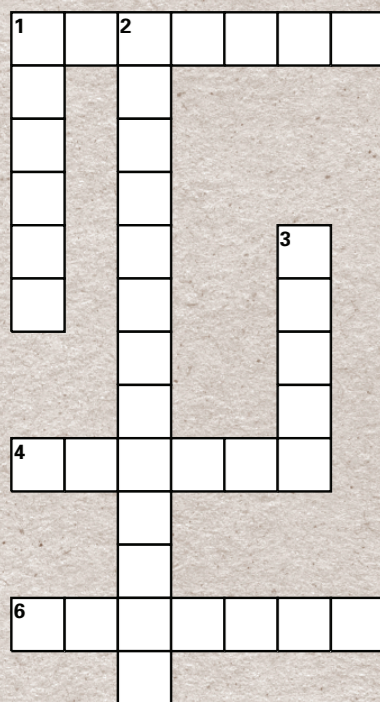

# NEBRASKA ENVIRONMENTAL TRUST

## Preserving Natural Nebraska™



The Nebraska Environmental Trust was established in 1992 to conserve, enhance and restore the natural environments of Nebraska. It was created on the conviction that a prosperous future is dependent upon a sound natural environment and that Nebraskans could collectively achieve real progress on real environmental issues if seed money were provided. Over \$342 million in lottery proceeds has been provided to the Nebraska Environmental Trust for natural resources projects all across the state.

As many backyard do-it-yourself warriors, farmers and ranchers alike look forward to spring, habitat planning comes to the forefront. Whether large or small scale, Pheasants Forever & Quail Forever of Nebraska are using funding from the Nebraska Environmental Trust to achieve habitat goals.

Pathway For Wildlife (PFW) offers incentives to enhance wildlife habitat on cropland, working lands, and within local communities. Participants apply specific wildlife and pollinator conservation practices to benefit pheasants, quail, grassland songbirds, monarch butterflies, native bees, and other wildlife. Additionally, the program aims to reduce soil loss, encourage

soil health and improve water quality.

PFW includes three program options: Pathway for Grasslands, Pathway for Precision Ag Conservation, and Pathway for Community Habitat. Each route offers a 1-3 year contract, 75-100% cost-share, requires no cropping history, and allows for annual payment options.

Pathway for Grasslands assists in rebuilding degraded grassland areas for better yield on cattle operations, or to establish native grasses and wildflowers for transition from cropland. Pathway for Precision Ag Conservation provides cover crops to benefit soil health, reduce weed competition, and provide awareness of an economic incentive to farming alternatives (limited to the Rainwater Basin). Pathway for Community Habitat plants native flowers in urban settings benefiting pollinators of all types – which is great for city parks, libraries, churches and other frequently-visited public areas. To date, almost 20,000 acres of habitat enhancement have been enrolled in PFW since 2019.

## MORE DRAWS FOR LUCKY FOR LIFE

Lucky for Life is getting an upgrade that will add five more chances to win each week.

The Lucky for Life game will be changing from two draws a week to daily drawings on July 19. Soon you'll be able to play every day for a chance to win up to \$1,000 a day for life.

"The decision by the game group to add drawings increases the opportunities for players to win \$1,000 a day for life, and reinforces the overall brand nationwide," said Brian Rockey, Nebraska Lottery Director. "We also expect to generate additional proceeds for good causes across Nebraska."

Lucky for Life tickets will still cost

\$2 per play, and prizes will remain unchanged. To prepare for the change to seven day draws, starting on April 26 the amount of drawings that can be purchased in advance for Lucky for Life will be temporarily reduced. The maximum number of drawings that can be purchased on a multi-draw ticket decreases by one after each successive drawing until July 19. See nelottery.com for details.

In August 2017, the Nebraska Lottery become the 25th lottery to join the multi-state Lucky for Life Lotto game. To date, one \$25,000 a year for life and 53 \$5,000 winning Lucky for Life tickets have been sold in Nebraska.

# WINNING WAYS

## Scribner Man Claims First Truck\$ & Buck\$ Truck



Michael Homes of Scribner is the first winner of a 2021 Ford F-150 XLT 4x4 SuperCrew Flex Fuel truck in the 26th edition of the Nebraska Lottery's \$2 Truck\$ & Buck\$ Scratch game.

Homes purchased his winning ticket at Scribner Express at 205 Railroad St. in Scribner.

Nebraska Lottery officials presented Homes with his prize on Tuesday, February 2 at Scribner Express.

Homes said he's been playing Truck\$ & Buck\$ ever since he moved back to Nebraska in 2009. When he bought his winning ticket, he picked up three Mega Millions tickets as well as three Truck\$ & Buck\$ tickets.

He scratched the ticket off at a friend's house. When he showed his friends he'd won a truck, they thought he was joking. Homes called the store owner where he'd bought his ticket and then raced back to check and make sure it was actually a winner.

The 26th edition of the Nebraska Lottery's popular \$2 Truck\$ & Buck\$ Scratch game features the 2021 Ford F-150 XLT 4x4 SuperCrew Flex Fuel truck as its top prize. Players have the opportunity to win one of seven Ford F-150 trucks as well as cash and Ethanol-enriched fuel prizes. The truck prize is valued at \$56,600, which includes \$1,199 for costs associated with ownership and state and federal withholding paid by the Nebraska Lottery of \$2,830 and \$13,584, respectively. The odds of winning the top prize in Truck\$ & Buck\$ are 1 in 300,000, while the overall odds of winning any prize are 1 in 3.65.
