LOTTERY PROCEEDS FOR EDUCATION



Did you know that when you buy a Nebraska Lottery ticket, you're helping to support students in our state? Proceeds for education are used as directed by the Nebraska Legislature, and over \$395 million has been raised for education since 1993.

Lottery proceeds are transferred quarterly to the Nebraska Education Improvement Fund and then distributed as follows:

- 62% to the Nebraska Opportunity Grant Fund for need-based scholarships at postsecondary institutions across Nebraska.

The Opportunity Grant is a Pell grant program administered by Nebraska's Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education (CCPE) for helping students in need. The money is distributed to colleges and universities throughout the state, who then give it to chosen applicants to use for educational expenses such as tuition, housing, and textbooks.

- 17% to the Department of Education Innovative Grant Fund to offer competitive innovation grants for the development, expansion, and investment in innovative best practices for education.

Using lottery proceeds, the Nebraska Department of Education offers competitive Innovation Grants across the state. Grant projects range from personalized learning, career academies, after school design networks, and digital ecosystem development. These funds are also used to offer free ACT testing to all juniors at Nebraska public schools.

- 9% to the Community College Gap Assistance Program Fund to offer financial aid to community college students enrolled in programs that could lead to jobs in high-need fields.
- 8% to the Excellence in Teaching Cash Fund to provide forgivable loans for Nebraska residents currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate teacher education program at an eligible Nebraska institution.
- 3% to fund distance learning education initiatives.
- 1% for after-school programs.

Omaha Woman Wins \$1 Million Playing Powerball

Wendy Donahue of Omaha won \$1 million playing Powerball from the Nebraska Lottery.

Donahue purchased her ticket at Baker's #321 at 505 N 155th Plaza in Omaha. The ticket contained a winning play for the July 25 drawing which matched all five white ball numbers (25, 37, 38, 39, 65).

Before taking home the \$1 million prize, Donahue said the biggest thing she'd ever won was a cake in a cake walk when she was 14.

She used to be a daily Powerball player until she decided to play a little less. When the Mega Millions jackpot grew to more than \$1 billion, she stopped at Baker's to pick up a few tickets. And, because old habits die hard, she decided to play Powerball as well.

Donahue and her husband Kevin heard there'd been a \$1 million ticket sold at their Baker's, so they decided to dig through their numbers.

"We thought, 'What if?'," Donahue said. "I zoned in on the third line and said, 'I think we hit \$1 million!' We were both screaming."

The Donahues quickly put their winning ticket in the safe until they could make it down to the Nebraska Lottery's Lincoln offices on July 29. When the day came, they carefully placed the ticket in her purse and put it gently in the backseat of their car.

"That was the most stressful drive of my life," Kevin said.

If you're wishing to win some cash this holiday season, we've got a new lineup of holiday Scratch games and a second-chance promotion for you.

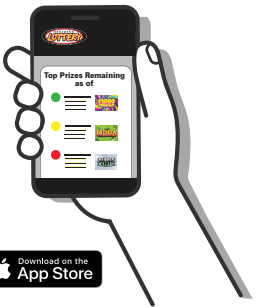

COMING SOON: DOUBLE PLAY

Something big is coming to Nebraska Powerball in 2023: Double Play.

Adding Double Play for an additional \$1 makes your Powerball numbers eligible for a second drawing that occurs after the Powerball drawing. Double Play prizes range from \$7 up to \$10 million and cannot be multiplied by the Power Play number.

Double Play will go on sale in Nebraska starting in January 2023.
