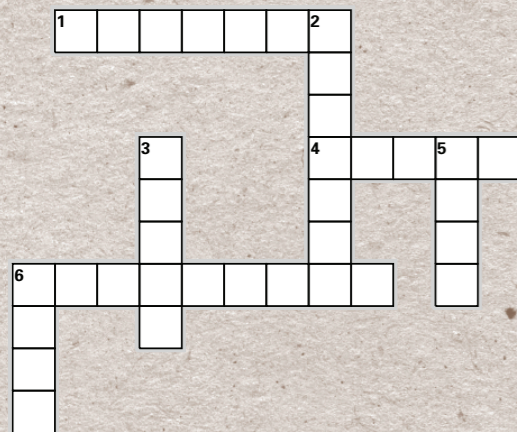

Powerball, America's Game is celebrating 30 years of making millionaires!

Powerball began April 19, 1992, with a starting jackpot of \$2 million. On July 21, 1994, Powerball became the first Lotto game offered by the new Nebraska Lottery. It continues to be Nebraska's favorite Lotto game.

Over the years, hundreds of millionaires have been created across the country by playing Powerball. This includes 10 Powerball jackpot winners and 26 \$1 million winners here in

Nebraska. Ticket sales have helped to generate over \$855 million for good causes across Nebraska.

To commemorate the Powerball 30th Anniversary, the Nebraska Lottery is offering a special promotion. Between April 18 and April 20, free Powerball Power Play tickets will be randomly produced with Powerball purchases. So buy a Powerball ticket between April 18 – 20 and you might take home a free Powerball Power Play ticket.

WINNING WAYS

Truck\$ & Buck\$ Trucks Won in Ceresco & Omaha



The first two Ford F-150 trucks in the Truck\$ & Buck\$ Scratch game were claimed at the beginning of March.

Richard Fortner of Lincoln claimed the first truck on March 4. Fortner purchased his winning Truck\$ & Buck\$ ticket at Super C #9 at 317 S Hwy 77 in Ceresco.

It was a thirst for something fizzy that led Fortner to buying his winning ticket, he said. “My wife loves fountain soda,” he said. “So the other day we had nothing to do so she says to run up to Ceresco and buy her a pop and get a couple of Scratch tickets, so I do that.”

His wife, Kathleen Fortner, described herself as a big fan of pop.

“I am the refill queen,” she said.

Fortner brought Kathleen her drink and sat down to scratch his tickets while she talked on the phone. He scratched off three piggy bank symbols in a row and revealed the truck prize.

As far as driving his new truck, Fortner’s not entirely sure what he’ll do. He’s already got a pickup, so he might have plans for the truck he won. “I don’t know exactly,” he said. “I had a thought that I may give it to my grandson. But then again, I may not.”

The second truck-winning ticket was sold at Baker’s #311, 5555 N 90th Street in Omaha and was claimed on March 7. The winner declined publicity about their win.

The truck prize is valued at \$58,900, which includes \$1,162 for costs associated with ownership and state and federal withholding paid by the Nebraska Lottery of \$2,945 and \$14,136, respectively. The odds of winning the top prize in Truck\$ & Buck\$ are 1 in 336,000, while the overall odds of winning any prize are 1 in 3.69.
