

The Nebraska Lottery is celebrating 30 years of funding, fortune and fun. One way we help fund educational opportunities in our state is through the Nebraska Opportunity Grant (NOG).


If someone you know is currently in college or planning on attending college soon, you should know about NOG. It's the State of Nebraska's only need-based financial aid program for post-secondary students. NOG is funded through State General Fund appropriations and Nebraska Lottery proceeds. Increases in NOG funding over the past 10 years have come primarily through these Lottery proceeds.

Who is eligible for NOG

The Nebraska Opportunity Grant provides financial aid to students who:

- are residents of Nebraska;
- have not earned a bachelor's, graduate or professional degree;
- · have high financial need; and
- are attending eligible Nebraska colleges/universities to earn a degree or credential.


In the 2021-22 academic year, 13,188 Nebraska students received a grant averaging \$1,721 at these schools:

NEBRASKA PICK 5 ENHANCEMENTS COMING AUGUST 13 nebraska



Nebraska's game Nebraska Pick 5 is getting an upgrade on August 13, 2023. Two numbers will be added, so players will select five numbers between 1 and 40 to play. Matching four of the five winning numbers will increase to \$500. And every time the jackpot is not won it will increase by \$10,000. The odds of winning the jackpot will be 1 in 658,008, while the overall odds will be 1 in 9.2.

To prepare for these game changes, the number of Nebraska Pick 5 drawings that can be purchased in advance will be temporarily reduced. The maximum number of drawings that can be purchased on a multi-draw ticket decreases by one after each successive drawing. Beginning Sunday, August 13, players will again be able to purchase tickets for up to 12 weeks of drawings (84 draws).

Fairmont Woman Wins \$3,000 Playing Nebraska Pick 3. Again.

DeAnna Smith of Fairmont won \$3,000 playing Nebraska Pick 3 from the

Smith purchased her ticket at Petro Stopping Center at 4700 S Lincoln Ave. in York. The ticket contained five straight plays for the June 1 drawing, each of which matched the winning numbers 3-4-9.

This is far from Smith's first big Pick 3 win. It's not even her first big win of 2023

Just this year she claimed a \$3,000 Pick 3 prize in March, a \$2,400 Pick 3 prize in January and on December 29, 2022, she claimed a \$3,600 Pick 3 prize. A little under a year ago in July 2022, Smith claimed a \$15,000 Pick 3 prize.

She'll get a feeling, she said. For some reason a three-digit number just seems like a lucky pick. Sometimes it's the ones she missed that keep her playing.

"I was driving to York and the price of diesel was \$3.49," she said. "I had to play it this time because the day before the price was \$3.53 and that was the winning number."

Having missed the 3-5-3 winning combination on May 31, Smith bought herself five tickets for the June 1 drawing with the numbers 3-4-9.

"It's just a feeling," she said.
